GUIDELINES

Art. 1 - The Centro Studi Umanistici "M. Tullio Cicerone" of Arpino, in collaboration with the I'Istituto di Istruzione Superiore "Tulliano", announces the XL CERTAMEN CICERONIANUM ARPINAS, a Latin competition. Participation is reserved to students of the last year of Italian classical and scientific high schools, promoted to the last year by a grade not less than 8/10 in Latin, to pupils of the corresponding foreign schools in which Latin is studied and to students coming from Non-European countries. No more than **three (3) students** may take part, accompanied by no more than two (2) accompanying teachers for each school. If the days of CERTAMEN coincide with the exams in foreign schools, the participation of students from the penultimate year is allowed.

The Board of Directors reserves the right to evaluate, on a motivated request of the interested institutions, any particular forms and conditions of participation.

Art. 2 - The proof will deal with the Latin version of a piece by Cicero. Moreover, with a short comment, the competitor will have to clarify his interpretation of the steps that will seem to him worthy of being underlined both for the language and for the content. Either for the version or for the comment, the candidate will use his own mother tongue.

Art. 3 - The CERTAMEN will take place in the classrooms of the "Istituto di Istruzione Tulliano" of Arpino, Classic Lyceum Section, on **8th of May 2020, at 8.30**. The test will last for 5 hours and the use of the dictionary will be allowed. The modalities of the test will be those of public competitions.

Art. 4 - The participants must submit the application form to the Director of their school, who will send it by the 10th of April 2020 to the President of the Centro Studi Umanistici 'M. Tullio Cicerone' - Corso Tulliano - 03033 ARPINO (Frosinone) ITALY. Competitors from non-European countries may submit applications for participation also through their respective Embassies or Consulates, by the date indicated above. The enrolled School **will have to pay a fee equal to € 220.00 (two hundred and twenty / 00 €) for each student and each accompanying teacher, net of bank charges, in favor of the Centro Studi Umanistici 'M. Tullio Cicerone' of Arpino by Bank Wire Transfer to Banca Popolare del Cassinate Agency of Arpino, for Italian schools IBAN Code: IT 54 N 0537274330000010547693; for foreign schools IBAN Code: IT 54 N 0537274330000010547693 + BIC Code POCAIT3c**. The receipt of the payment must be attached to the application form.

Nothing else is owed by the participants.

Applications for participation, along with the forms for consent to the processing and dissemination of personal data of the participating students (Annex A) and accompanying teachers (attachment B), duly completed and signed, and upon receipt of payment, must be sent by e-mail to Organization@certamenciceronianum.it.

Art. 5 - Participating students must bring with them a valid identification document.

Art. 6 - The panel of judges, appointed by the President of the Centro Studi Umanistici, will be composed by university professors, headmasters and teachers of Classical Languages, even at rest. In no way can professors who teach in institutions attended by students participating in the Certamen be part of the commission. The rules of public competitions also apply to the Commission.

Art. 7 - The panel of judges will award, at its sole discretion, the prizes offered; can also attribute "honorable mentions".
